



On/Off Switch

Push the switch to "ON" and the keyboard is turned on.

BUTTON

Connect Press "Connect" key 2 to 3 Sec, Keyboard blue light is flashing, indicating that the keyboard enters the pairing mode.

LED 5

Charge: When the led lamp is flashing, it indicates that the battery in the keyboard will be used up, and the keyboard needs to be charged in time; when the keyboard battery is full, this indicator is automatically extinguished.

Status Light: When the device powers on, the light twinkes quickly,


